 The instant complaint has been filed by Smt. Rekha Sharma against the Respondent company under section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for violation of Regulations 52 & 53 of the DERC Regulation, 2007. She is R/o Khasra No. 64, New Mandoli Indul. Area, Delhi – 110 093, and having

electricity connection K. No. 1260V7741235 for non-domestic category with 25KW sanctioned load.

- 2. The Respondent has filed an affidavit on 29.09.2011 stating that the aforesaid matter had already been amicably settled between petitioner and respondent company in June, 2011. The Respondent has also attached a copy of the letter written by petitioner to the Respondent showing satisfaction on the mutual and amicable settlement of the above dispute and giving undertaking not to proceed in the matter further with the DERC or other where.
- 3. In pursuance of the above affidavit, Commission issued a letter to the Petitioner seeking confirmation from her on the above settlement and gave 15 days time to reply from the receipt of letter. The letter was issued on 07.10.2011. However, no response has been received from the petitioner till today.
- 4. The Petitioner was also informed through this letter that in absence of her non-submission of confirmation, it will be presumed that she is no more interested to press her prayer /grievance and the said complaint shall be treated as amicably settled and withdrawn.
- 5. The above matter was listed on 28.02.2012 for hearing in the Commission which was attended by above representatives of the Respondent however, no one appeared on behalf of the complainant. The Commission while acceding to the request of the complainant for withdrawal of her complaint in terms of amicable settlement decides to dispose off the above complaint as amicably settled and withdrawn.
