In the matter of: Order dtd. 10/01/2022

Whereas, the Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission vide Order dated 10/01/2022, in exercise of its powers conferred under Regulation 85 (Power of relaxation and power to remove difficulties) of the DERC (Supply Code and Performance Standards) Regulations, 2017 (hereinafter referred to as 'Regulations'), considered the outbreak of Covid-19 as a Force Majeure event under Regulation 83 of the Regulations for suspension of Standards of Performance w.e.f. 05/01/2022, till further Orders.

And Whereas the Govt. of NCT of Delhi had eased certain Covid-19 related restrictions in the national capital w.e.f. 27th January 2022 vide Delhi Disaster Management Authority Order No.F.60/DDMA/COVID-19/2021/Vol-II/515 dated 27.01.2022.

Accordingly, the Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission has now decided, from the date of issuance of this Order, to revoke the Order dated 10/01/2022 regarding suspension of Standards of Performance.
