## Item No. 1

Approval of Minutes of 16<sup>th</sup> SAC Meeting held on 29.03.2017.

### Item No. 2

Review of "Action Taken Report (ATR)" on issues discussed in the previous meetings.

The Committee considered and approved the "Action Taken Report (ATR)" placed along with the agenda items.

Item No. 3:-

Tariff Petition for True up of FY 2016-17 and ARR for FY 2018-19 for GENCOs, TRANSCO and DISCOMs.

A presentation on Tariff Petition for True up of FY 2016-17 and ARR for FY 2018-19 for GENCOs, TRANSCO and DISCOMs was made before the Committee. It was informed that the petition for True up of FY 2016-17 and ARR for FY 2018-19 has been filed by the Distribution & Transmission Licensees and Generation Companies and the same have been admitted. The Commission has uploaded the petition along with Executive Summary of the petitions prepared by the officers of the Commission on the DERC website for public comments and suggestions. During the presentation, the Committee was apprised about the tariff determination exercise, tariff provisions under the Electricity Act 2003 and brief snapshot of the petitions.

The Committee was apprised about achievements of the Commission during FY 2017-18 and it was further informed that Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission (DERC) bagged the "DIAMOND" award at India Smart Grid Forum (ISGF), a Public Private Partnership initiative of Ministry of Power (MoP), Government of India in the category of "Innovative Policies and Regulations Promoting Renewable and Smart Grids in India", for its contribution in formulating environmental friendly policies and promoting renewable energy. The Committee Members appreciated and congratulated the Commission for the same.

Item No. 4:-

Approach Paper on Tariff Rationalization.

A presentation on the Approach Paper on Tariff Rationalization was made and proposal was explained to the Committee Members. It was informed that an Approach Paper has been prepared by the Commission on the issues & various steps required to promote Competition in Retail Supply and the Commission has invited Comments/suggestions from all stakeholders. Therefore, the Committee Members were also requested to provide their valuable comments/ suggestions on the same.

Item No. 5:-

Energy Audit of the DISCOMs.

A presentation was made on the current status of the Energy Audit and the Committee was apprised that the same is under process.
