## <u>ORDER</u>

- The instant petition has been filed by Shri Davinder (User) under Section 142
  of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. for violation of
  the procedure as laid down in the Delhi Electricity Supply Code and
  Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
- 2. Notice of the petition was issued on 21.03.2016 to Respondent to file its reply. In response to the above notice, the Respondent filed its reply on 08.06.2016.
- 3. The above matter was listed for hearing in the Commission on 22.11.2016, which was attended by the Respondent, however, no appearance was made from the Petitioner side neither any information was received. The

Commission granted one last opportunity to the Petitioner and adjourned the

hearing for a future date.

4. In the meantime the Petitioner filed an application dated 02.02.2017 before

the Commission whereby he has sought permission of the Commission to

withdraw the said matter as the said matter have been amicably settled

between both the parties in National Lok Adalat.

5. An affidavit dated 23.02.2017, has also been filed by the Respondent stating

that the aforesaid matter had been amicably settled between both the

parties before the Special Lok Adalat held in the Saket Court on 11.12.2016. A

copy of a Special Lok Adalat Order/Settlement Agreement has also been

furnished alongwith the affidavit.

6. In view of the facts stated above, the request of the Petitioner to withdraw

the case is acceded to and accordingly the petition is dismissed as

withdrawn.
