The Bidders furnishing false /fabricated experience certificate /documents shall be debarred from participating in any tenders issued by DERC.

Annexure 2**General Terms & Conditions**

1. **Description of Work:-** Construction of Rain Water Harvesting System in DERC premises.
2. **The Scope of Work:-** Construction of rain water harvesting system of size 4.00 m X 4.00 m x 4.00 m. Items are to be carried out as per details mentioned in the bill of quantity stated in the Financial bid / description of the work as per the Financial bid. Boring & lowering of casing will be executed strictly as per specifications up to the required depth. No T&P or any other materials will be provided by the DERC. Work includes the removal of the excavated earth, debris etc. & disposal of the same from the working place to outside the DERC office Complex at an appropriate place without disturbing the routine functioning of the Commission & without defacement of the property/vehicles etc. of the Commission and also keeping the environmental aspect in view. The bidder shall ensure the workable area in safe clean & clear in all respect. Any type of loss or damage what so ever that may be occurred during the execution of the work shall be responsibility of the bidder/contractor to make good at him own cost.
3. EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned after the award of the contract. The EMD of the successful bidder would be returned, after receipt of Performance Bank Guarantee/ Fixed Deposit/Demand Draft Receipt which should be equivalent to 10% of the contract value.
4. **Manner of depositing the Bids: -**
 - i. **Bids shall be submitted in three separate envelopes, namely;**
 - (i) Earnest Money Deposit
 - (ii) Technical bid
 - (iii) Financial bid

The envelopes shall mention name of assignment and content of envelope (EMD/Technical Bid/Financial Bid) at the top, and the name of the submitting bidder at the left hand corner of the envelope. The bids shall be submitted in the enclosed formats.
 - ii. **These three envelopes shall be sealed in a large envelope. This envelope shall mention name of assignment at the top and the name of the submitting bidder at the left hand corner of the envelope.**
 - iii. **Earnest Money Deposit:-** Bidders are required to submit Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) for an amount of **Rs. 8,000/-** along with their bids. However, Bidders registered with Micro Small and Medium Enterprises / National Small Industries Corporation (MSME/NSIC) are exempted from depositing EMD as per the provisions of GFR 181. The EMD is to be submitted in the form of an Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of "*Secretary, Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission*" payable at New Delhi from any of the Public Sector Banks. The EMD or MSME/NSIC certificate is to

be submitted in a separate sealed envelope, which shall be opened first. In case, there is no appropriate EMD or MSME/NSIC certificate in that envelope, the Technical & Financial Bids will not be opened for that Bidder. Bids without EMD will be rejected as non-responsive.

- iv. The Technical bid shall comprise of duly filled Annexure-3 and signed alongwith all enclosures specified at Annexure-3. **In case all the documents in support of eligibility criteria mentioned in Annexure-3 are not found enclosed in the technical bid envelope, the bid shall be summarily rejected as non-responsive and financial bid of such bidders shall not be opened.** All Technical documents like literature, catalogues, etc., if any, shall be placed in the same sealed envelope of technical bid. The technical bid shall not include particulars of the Financial bids otherwise the bids shall be liable to be rejected.
- v. Each page of bid should be numbered and signed by the authorized signatory with the seal of the Bidder. Further, any cutting, addition or overwriting on any page of the bid, shall be clearly marked and signed by the authorized signatory.
- vi. A Power of Attorney duly notarised by the Notary Public, indicating that the person(s) signing the bid has the authority to sign the bid and that the bid is binding upon the Bidder during the full period of its validity, shall be submitted.
5. No change in the amount of bid shall be permitted after submission of the bids. All the documents shall be duly signed and stamped by authorized person of bidder/supplier.
6. Sealed Bids should be either dropped in the Tender Box placed at Commission's Reception or sent by registered post at the address of Commission so as to reach on or before by 1500 Hrs on _____. Late tenders will not be considered. No responsibility will be taken for postal delay or non-delivery/non-receipt of Bid documents. Bids sent by FAX or E-mail will not be considered.
7. Bidders are advised to visit the O/o DERC to assess the required work and familiarize themselves with the local conditions and the work involved. The Bidders may, accordingly quote their rates for the required work.
8. **Specifications:-** Construction of Rain Water Harvesting System in DERC premises shall strictly be as per specifications/ description stated in Bill of Quantity (BOQ) in Annexure-4.
9. **Time and date for opening of Bids:-** The bids will be opened on **04.10.2019 at 1600 Hrs.** If due to any exigency, the due date for opening of the Bids is declared a closed holiday, the Bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time or on any other day/time, as intimated by DERC. The Bidders may depute their representatives, duly authorized in writing, to attend the opening of Bids. This event will not be postponed due to non-presence of representative of the bidder.

10. **Rejection of Bids:-** Canvassing by the Bidder in any form, unsolicited letter and post-tender correction, unsigned bids shall be summarily rejected and may lead to forfeiture of EMD. Conditional/part tenders will also be rejected.
11. **Validity of Bids:-** The prices quoted in the Bids shall remain valid for **90 days** from the last date of submission of the Bids.
12. **Bid Tender amount, Taxes and Duties:-** The Bidder shall quote separately, the base price of works, and applicable taxes & duties. The base price of works shall be firm and final. No escalation whatsoever shall be payable. The applicable taxes and duties shall be paid as per actual.
13. **Contract agreement:-** The successful bidder shall sign an agreement within 10 working days of issuance of Work Order by the Commission and also simultaneously furnish a "*Performance Guarantee*" of 10% (Ten percent) of the Contract value in form of Bank Guarantee/Fixed Deposit/Demand Draft Receipt in favour of "*Secretary, Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission*", to be valid for a period of 15 months from the date of successful completion and handing over of works. In case, the successful bidder fails to enter into the said contract agreement and/or fails to furnish the desired "*Performance Guarantee*" within 10 working days from the issuance of the Work Order/Award Letter, the Commission at any stage reserves the right to terminate the Contract and forfeit the EMD.
14. **Indemnity Bond:-** The successful Bidder shall submit an indemnity bond, indemnifying DERC from the following, on a stamp paper of Rs. 100 duly signed by the authorized signatory within 10 working days from the date of work order, and before commencement of work at site whichever is earlier conditions may be:-
- (a) Any third party claims, civil or criminal complaints /liabilities, site mishaps, fire hazards and other accidents including death of any person/s or dispute and /or damages occurring, or arising out of any mishaps at site due to his/his employee/representative fault or negligence.
 - (b) All claims, demands, actions, proceedings, losses, damages, liabilities, cost, charges, expenses or obligations that are occasioned to or may occasion to the Contractor as a result of nonpayment of any statutory dues levied/Taxes e.g. leviable on the Contractor or the Contractor committing breach of any of the rules, regulations, orders, directives, instructions that may be issued by any authority under the Central Government/State Govt. or any statute or law for the time being in force.
 - (c) Any damages, loss, death or expenses due to or resulting from any negligence or breach of duty on his/his employee/representative part.
15. **Defect Liability Period:-** The defect liability period of the works shall be 12 months after successful completion and handing over of work.

16. Evaluation criteria. The bidder should quote price as per the details provided at Financial Bid. The quantity multiplied by rate shall be verified and in case of any arithmetical error, the rate quoted shall be taken for evaluation. The lowest evaluated price of the bidder shall be selected for the award of the contract.
17. **Terms of Work Order:-**
- (a) The successful bidder shall have to complete the works within 60 days from the date of Work Order unless the period is extended by mutual agreement.
- (b) The material used in the works must be of good condition. Old/Sub-standard/re-refabricated used/ open seal material will be returned and vendor will have to replace such material at his own expense.
18. **Payment terms:-**
- Bills shall be submitted by the Contractor after completion of the work to DERC. Payment will be released to the contractor after verification of the bill. TDS and any other amounts as may be withheld/deductible or recoverable in terms of the contract.
- Payment of the Contractor's bills shall be made by the DERC within 30 days from the date of submission of the bill subject to the acceptance of the DERC.
- (a) The bills shall be raised in favor of "*Secretary, Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission*".
- (b) Payment will be released through RTGS/NEFT/IMPS in the name of Contractor.
- (c) Payment shall be made after deducting applicable taxes at source and any other recovery as per the terms of the contract.
19. Liquidated Damages. The works of Construction of Rain Water Harvesting System in DERC premises mentioned in BOQ shall be completed within the time schedule as indicated herewith. The Contractor shall be liable to pay liquidated damages as compensation for an amount equal to 0.25 % of the contract price of the entire work for every day's delay in providing service but not exceeding 10% on the total contract price.
20. **Termination of Contract:-** The Commission shall have the right to terminate this Contract in part or in full in any of the following cases, if:-
- (a) The work is delayed for more than 10 days beyond the scheduled date indicated in the work Order, for reasons attributable to the Contractor
- (b) The Contractor is declared bankrupt or becomes insolvent or supplies sub-standard material/consumables.
- (c) For any other reasons which is in the opinion of Commission warrants cancellation of contract award.
21. In case the successful bidder fails to fulfill its obligations as per the work order/contract agreement, the Commission would be entitled to forfeit the Performance Bank Guarantee.

22. **Power Supply:-** The Contractor shall make arrangements for the full anticipated requirement of construction power by installing Diesel Generating sets (without noise/silent) and operate these sets for generation of power required for execution of Works under the Contract, at no extra cost to the DERC.
23. The Contractor at his own cost shall provide and install all necessary electrical installations and other temporary equipment for further distribution and utilization of energy for power and lighting and shall remove the same on completion of the Works. All work areas shall be provided with appropriate illumination by the Contractor at his own expenses for their proper execution and inspection in accordance with the provisions of laws in force.
24. The Contractor shall provide, at his own cost, all materials, plants, tools, equipment's, appliances, implements, Ladder, cordages, tackle, scaffolding and temporary works, required for proper execution of the work, whether original, altered or substituted and whether included in the specifications or other documents forming part of the contract or not, or which may be necessary for the purpose of satisfying or complying with the requirements of the DERC as to any matter under these conditions he is entitled to be satisfied, or which he is entitled to require together with carriage thereof to and from the work. The Contractor shall deploy without charge the requisite personnel with means and materials, necessary for the purpose of setting out the works, counting, weighting, and assisting in measurements or examination of the work from time to time.
- 24 No payment shall be made by the DERC for generation, distribution and consumption of electricity in execution of Works by the Contractor.
- 25 **Supply of Water:-** The Contractor shall make his own arrangements for water required for and in connection with the work at his cost. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to satisfy himself that the water arranged by him is fit for construction & consumption and he shall adequately treat such water whenever it is not found fit for the said purposes.
25. The work shall be carried out by the Contractor in a manner complying all respect with the requirement of relevant bye-laws/orders of the Local/Municipal bodies and pay all fees and charges at his own cost. Wherever local bye-laws require engagement of licensed Plumbers/Electrical inspectors or any other specialized persons, the Contractor shall engage them at his own cost. The completion certificates, wherever applicable, to meet the statutory obligations, shall be arranged by the Contractor.
26. The quantities shown against the various items of works are approximate. Any increase or decrease in the quantities shall not form the basis for alteration of the rates quoted and accepted.

27. In case of items for which rates are not available in the Bill of Quantities, the rates of such items as far as practicable, shall be derived from the quoted rates of analogous item(s) in the Bill of Quantities.
28. In the cases, where analogous items are not available in the Bill of Quantities and, such items shall be termed as extra items, the Contractor, within 15 days (or as agreed by the DERC) of receipt of order to execute such items shall submit rate analysis to the DERC supported by documentary evidence of basic rates adopted therein, notwithstanding the fact that the rates for such items exist in the Contract, having regard to the cost of materials (including transportation and taxes, levies if paid), actual wages for labour and ownership & operational cost of construction equipment as per standard norms or if standard norms are not specified/available then on the basis of labour/materials/equipment actually engaged for the particular work. The standard norms for materials and labour specified herein shall mean those specified in prevalent 'Delhi Schedule of Rates' with declared premium.
29. The DERC shall examine the rate analysis submitted by the Contractor and fix the rates accordingly whose decision shall be conclusive, final and binding on the Contractor.
30. The Contractor shall provide, at his own cost, all materials, tools, equipments, appliances, required for proper execution of the work.
