**ORDER**

(Date of Order: 15.06.2015)

1. The instant petition has been filed by Smt. Vanitha Rao under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. for violation of the procedure laid down in the Delhi Electricity Regulatory Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
2. A notice of the petition was issued on 03.02.2015 to Respondent to file its reply.
3. The Commission while admitting the above petition, vide its Interim Order dated 23.04.2015, directed the Respondent to show cause on the prima facie findings of violations of Regulation 52 (viii) read with Regulation 38 (c), 52 (ix), 52 (x) and 52 (xi) and 53 (ii) of Delhi Electricity Supply Code & Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.

4. Subsequently, an affidavit dated 26.05.2015 has been received from the Respondent stating that the dispute has been settled amicably between the parties and being satisfied with the settlement, the Petitioner has agreed to withdraw the complaint. The Respondent has also provided a copy of a letter dated 12.05.2015 from one Shri Vijay Kumar, claiming to be the authorized representative of Smt. Vanitha Rao, wherein it is stated that the complainant has no grievance left and she does not wish to pursue with the matter any further as the matter had already been settled between the petitioner and the Respondent company. The Complainant seeks permission of this Commission to withdraw the said complaint.
5. In view of the facts stated above, the request of the petitioner to withdraw the case is acceded to and accordingly the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
